



The Sawyer County Forestry Department is accepting applications for a Forester position. This is a full-time 40-hour week position. This position performs a variety of duties to assist with the management of Sawyer County Forest, Parks and recreations roads and trails within the County in accordance with the Sawyer County Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan, Sawyer County Forest Ordinances, and applicable State Statutes, codes and guidelines.

Qualifications include Bachelor's degree in the field of Forestry Management or related field. Must demonstrate a working knowledge of forest management including dendrology, silvics, silviculture, timber cruising, aerial photo interpretation, cartography, land surveying, harvesting methods and systems, and recreational roads and trails construction and maintenance. Must possess a valid WI driver's license.
